### **Giving in Grace** (from the Diocese of Liverpool)

- Flexible web resource
- Breadth of resources (sermons, youth, bible studies, prayer resources)
- Good link with vision through case statement

### **A parish Funding Programme** (Developed nationally)

The programme has, at its heart, the discernment and communication of God's vision and purpose for the Parish, together with any planned initiatives. This forms the basis for assessing future funding needs and the required increase in planned giving.



### **A Simple Giving Programme for Smaller Churches** (Developed nationally) (<http://www.parishresources.org.uk/sgpl/>)

- This is designed for smaller or rural/village churches.
- In these churches, a greater percentage of the community are likely to be committed to the church than in other contexts.
- This programme encourages the church to consider whether it should approach the fringe/wider community, and also whether to hold a presentation event to communicate the financial needs of the parish
