Amen



## **Event Information and Programme**

Welcome to **Refresh.** We hope this information will tell you everything you need to know to make the most of your time at **Refresh**.

The Programme includes information about everything that is happening and where. The campus is built on a hillside, which leads to a rather complicated room numbering system as the ground floor is on different levels depending on the building you are in.

Our main conference venues are all located on or near one of the main squares as shown on the map below. Square 5 is the highest level and nearest to the Ivor Crewe Lecture Hall, where registration and our main events are happening.



Our workshops and seminars are either in the Lecture Theatre Building to the south of Square 3 or in the Tony Rich Teaching Centre to the north of Square 4 beyond the Hexagon. Our food outlets are also on Squares 3 and 4.

The squares are linked together by wide open stairs. Wheelchair access is possible throughout the campus by using the lifts which are located inside the buildings – these are shown on the map in the yellow circles.

#### **Emergencies**

You will receive more information from Event Essex with your room keys. The only fire alarm test expected during our gathering is in the University Quays accommodation at 1.30pm on Wednesday. All other alarms must be responded to.

In the case of medical emergencies, please call the number on the back of your name card. There are on-site first aiders who will call an ambulance if required.

#### **Prayer Space**

The University's Theatre Lab has been turned into a prayer space for **Refresh**. You will find this just inside the main entrance of the Tony Rich Teaching Centre (TC2.1). Please come and see – and, more importantly, pray.

#### Chaplaincy

We have a team of chaplains who are available if you want someone to talk to or pray with. Look out for the green lanyards. The team includes lay people, priests and bishops.

#### Workshops, Seminars and Activities

If you have not made your choices, we will have tickets for all the options where there are still spaces. These can be collected from the upper foyer outside the Ivor Crewe Lecture Hall during the lunch break on Tuesday.

#### **Bookstall and Displays**

The Diocesan Bookshop will be open each day during **Refresh** in the upper foyer of the Ivor Crewe Lecture Hall.

Various organisations have asked us to make their literature available. This can be picked-up from the table outside the Conference Hub in the lower foyer of the Ivor Crewe Lecture Hall.

We have invited a few organisations to bring displays to **Refresh** who have discipleship resources to offer. These are around the ground floor corridor of the Tony Rich Teaching Centre. Please find time to have a look.
