Four times a year you'll find the word "ember day" against dates in the Common Worship calendar, This has nothing to do with ashes or warm fires! It's simply an abbreviation of a German word meaning "four times a year". They mark the traditional "four times" a year, once each season, when Christians fast to thank God for his gifts and pray for particular concerns. They are days of penitence and prayer – themes that easily pass us by! There is a very early rule that ordinations should take place in ember weeks, and although we no longer keep that tradition, in the Church of England these are days when we traditionally pray for the ordained ministry.
