Who we are

The Diocese of Chelmsford is led by The Right Revd Stephen Cottrell, Bishop of Chelmsford, and is part of the Church of England which covers Essex, the unitary authorities of Southend and Thurrock and the five East London boroughs. We exist to support Christian service in each of our Episcopal Areas:

Bradwell

- The Bradwell Area is led by the Right Revd John Wraw, Bishop of Bradwell.
- Population: 958,380 (Census 2011).
- 277 ministers.
- 180 churches.
- The Archdeaonries of Chelmsford and Southend comprise 9 deaneries (Brentwood, Basildon, Chelmsford North, Chelmsford South, Maldon & Dengie, Hadleigh, Southend, Thurrock and Rochford).

Barking

- The Barking Area is led by the Right Revd Peter Hill, Bishop of Barking.
- Population: 1,468,020 (Census 2011).
- 272 ministers.
- 178 churches.
- The Archdeaonries of Harlow, West Ham and Barking comprise 7 deaneries (Havering, Barking & Dagenham, Epping Forest & Ongar, Harlow, Newham, Redbridge and Waltham Forest).

Colchester

- The Colchester Area is led by the Right Revd Roger Morris, Bishop of Colchester.
- Population: 545,130 (Census 2011).
- 221 ministers.
- 233 churches.
- The Archdeaonries of Colchester and Stansted comprise 8 deaneries (Saffron Walden, Dunmow and Stansted, Braintree, Hinchford, Colchester, Witham, Harwich and St Osyth).
