INSURANCE COVER

I HEREBY DIRECT that

1. Before contracting a firm or person to carry out works, a PCC must see evidence that it has:

- a. £10 million Public Liability insurance cover
and
- b. £10 million Employer's Liability insurance cover.

2. The only exception to this is where works:

- a. are carried out from ground level and
- b. do not require any form of power machinery (electric or power combustion).

Such works may be undertaken by a firm or person having not less than £5 million Public Liability and £5 million Employer's Liability insurance cover, evidence of which must be seen by the PCC.

3. Notwithstanding this exception, a stonemason installing, repairing or conserving a memorial in the churchyard must have £10 million Public Liability insurance cover. The stonemason is required on a CR1 form and petition for Faculty to sign a Certificate of Compliance confirming they have this level of insurance cover.

4. A PCC must check with its insurer that it has the necessary insurance cover when using voluntary labour.
